



## Grossmont Community College Digital Arts

Architects Mosher Drew worked with existing campus guidelines to provide an entry icon building and showcase for technology training. The firm provided programming, design, construction documents and construction phase services for the new Digital Arts Building for the Grossmont-Cuyamaca Community College District.

The 21,500-square-foot Digital Arts Building includes a wet photography facility, a photography studio and its digital counterpart: digital art labs and media labs. Additional media communications learning environments within the building are the KGFN campus radio station, an audio studio, a video studio and studio control facilities, editing labs, and a digital multimedia lab designed to merge music and video. Faculty offices are conveniently located close to the labs to allow for more student - teacher interaction. The high tech, multimedia facility opened for classes in 2007.
