



## Point Loma Nazarene University School of Business

The 15,000-square-foot Business Building consists of new and remodeled facilities. The two-story, wood framed facility includes one level of underground parking. The new facility incorporates the existing Fermanian Business Center, which promotes interaction between the academic campus and the private business sector.

The Business School accommodates the accounting, business and economics departments and consists of modern classrooms with wireless systems for instruction, Internet access, teleconferences, information technology, experimental learning labs, casual meeting areas and a Garden Terrace. The lecture halls, classrooms and seminar facilities are equipped with state-of-the-art "Smart Classroom Technology." Additional facilities include faculty offices, administration office, boardroom, student and faculty lounges to promote interaction between faculty and students.

To facilitate the program of the Fermanian Center, the new business facility includes a two-story parking structure providing dedicated parking for the many events.
