



Rady Children's Emergency, Orthopedics & Radiology Remodel

This 8,200-square-foot remodel of a portion of the first floor of the Rose Pavilion at Rady Children's Hospital and Health Care San Diego was completed in 2006. The work includes remodeling the existing Emergency Department, a new Orthopedics Department Radiology Suite and a refurbished Orthopedics Department Waiting Room. The design-build delivery method was used for this project.

The Emergency Department Remodel includes a new waiting room, greeting counter, two additional triage rooms, two additional exam rooms, and a fully remodeled nurse station. The waiting room features new finishes, furniture, artwork and a greeting counter that accommodates greeters, nurses, and security officials. Adjacent to the greeting counter, new larger assessment, intake, exam and triage rooms are provided. The nurse station provides improved flow, generous work, charting and doctor's write-up counter space, a medication room, soiled and clean linen rooms, and a trauma communications center.

The Orthopedics Department Remodel features a new Radiology Suite and a refurbished waiting room. The Radiology suite includes an X-ray suite fitted with imaging equipment and controls designed with the most current technologies. A casting room for setting broken bones is provided adjacent to the x-ray suite. The Orthopedics Department Waiting Room features new finishes, furniture, artwork and a greeting counters.

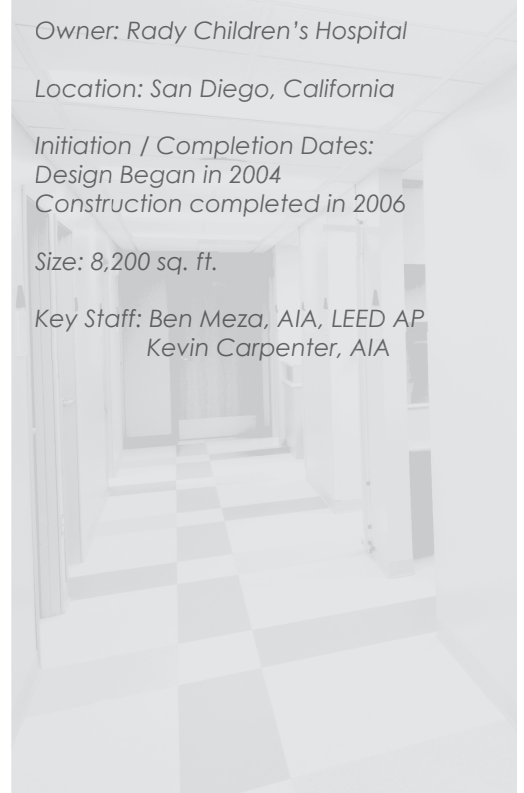
